**General Information**

1. Awards will be given for 1st through 6th place in each division.
2. Stalls are very limited - they are assigned in order of received complete registration and payment. Stalls are \$25 per night. Shavings available at \$6 per bag or you may supply your own. A separate stall deposit check of \$25 is required and will be destroyed when stall is stripped. Trailer tying is allowed for \$10 on the day of the event only. No overnight tying. Trailer areas must be picked/cleaned up before departure.
3. Entries are processed when all paperwork has been submitted and full payment received.
4. Closing date is September 9th. Late entries will be process based on space allowed and will incur a late registration fee of \$20.
5. Withdrawals are allowed prior to the closing date minus a \$25 office fee. No refunds given after the closing date unless accompanied by a note from a doctor or vet. No refunds for weather. In the event of rain/poor footing, the event will be run as a combined test.
6. Rules and penalty scoring for the mini-event can be found on the USEA website: [www.useventing.com](http://www.useventing.com). This is a schooling event and you will be allowed to complete the current phase/proceed to the next phase even if you are eliminated.
7. Dressage times will be emailed to competitors prior to the show and posted on Facebook. Readers are allowed.
8. Ground pole and pre-novice cross country (18") will be held in a fenced field.
9. Casual show attire is allowed. Braiding and coats are not required. Competitors must be in a sleeved shirt, have hard-soled heeled footwear, and an ASTM/SEI certified helmet. Protective vests for cross country are encouraged.
10. Medical armbands/bracelets are required for Pony Club members and are recommended for all riders.
11. X-country schooling is available Friday afternoon/evening for \$15. You MUST have a trainer to school cross country - no one is allowed on the course alone regardless of age or riding level. Specify trainer's name on the registration form. Please check in before schooling.
12. Overnight rustic camping is available for \$10.
13. Lunch will be available for pre-buy at a reduced rate of \$5 and on day of show for \$7. Drinks will be available for purchase. Otherwise plan to bring your own food and drink for the day.
